Subject: Citizen Proposal for Stevens Avenue Traffic

The following proposal was initiated by Mr. Marvin Dionne of 20 Elmwood Street, Portland, and it contains a much more acceptable, and we believe, much more adequate proposal for improving safety on Stevens Avenue than the one which was recently abandoned.

There are 398 signatures attached to this proposal. Three hundred fifty-nine of these were personally obtained by Mr. Dionne, and the other 39 were obtained by the Park Danforth management. A copy of the proposal had been left at the front desk for residents and visitors to the Park Danforth Apartments to sign if they wished.

Mr. Dionne personally interviewed each person whose signature he obtained, and would only accept the signatures of people who told him they were residents of Portland. We assume that almost all of them are voters, although this has not been verified.

Mr. Dionne asked me to see that this proposal reached the members of the Public Safety committee at the time of the public meeting on August 25.

He also asked me to emphasize to members of the committee that the paramount concern of almost everyone he talked with was PARKING! They insisted that, whatever is done, no parking areas or spaces that currently exist should in any way be affected. They feel that parking on both sides of Stevens Ave. is vital, not only for the small businesses and offices on the Avenue, but also in order to maintain the sense of neighborhood and community for people who have their homes there.

Copies of this proposal are also being distributed to other members of the Portland City Council and to the City Manager.
